

A Note From Our Pastor

I recently attended the funeral of a colleague from Evansville. Her daughter spoke about numerous memories of growing up with a clergy mother at a time when female clergy were few and far between. She laughed that only her mother would have the

guts to have her funeral during Holy Week, the Super Bowl for clergy everywhere. This year, Holy Week seems like both the Super Bowl and the Derby Festival all rolled into one. It was exhausting but so rewarding.

Actually, all of April was amazing. With terrible thunderstorms for a week, the Block Party was moved indoors. The number of participants doubled to over 100, and we were crowded but overjoyed at the turnout. Three days later, Messy Church welcomed 38 to our event, our highest attendance yet, with a neighborhood family attending who had been at the previous Block Party. Then, again with heavy rains, the Easter Egg Hunt was moved indoors, and we again doubled our regular attendance with 105 present, including the same neighborhood family whose young son greeted me with a hug. Talk about a "loaves and fishes" moment with the hot dogs. Everyone had a great time. Then all through Holy Week to Easter, we had over 130 in worship, including so many members of the Cooper family who came to watch Jillian be baptized. We rejoiced and celebrated the resurrection of Christ together as a church family. April was indeed a blessed month.

On May 4th we will celebrate our first Confirmation Class in several years. This is a fine group of young people, and I am so proud of them and their accomplishments. We're a bit excited (at least the boys and I) that Confirmation is taking place on *Star Wars* day—May the Fourth, as in *May the Fourth*

(Force) be With You. I encourage all of you to bring a card, a note, or a small gift for each of them and place it in their individually labelled bag in the front pew. Let's make this a very special rite of passage for them and show our love and support for them all.


Awards and Honors:
